

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING THE FIREPLACE

- Adjust the cooker hood power to position 1 (above the stove); otherwise the fireplace switch doesn't work.
- Push the fireplace switch (in the picture). It's located on the wall, behind the TV or in the hallway.
- Open the chimney cover(s).
- Open the air flow controls (grate) of the fireplace.
- Place the firewood vertically in the fire chamber. Leave some space between the pieces of firewood, so that the fire will get some air and burn properly. Don't overfill the fireplace.
- Add a handful of splinters of wood, some pieces of birch bark or crumpled newspaper between the firewood. Then light the fire.
- Once the fire has ignited and the chimney draws well, reduce the airflow using the controls (grate) or close them if needed. The automatic fireplace ventilator will close by itself after it has been about 20 minutes of operation.
- As long as you want to keep the fire, add one or two pieces of firewood at a time into the fireplace.
- The draft may be weaker than usual during low pressure and rain.
- When the fireplace hasn't been used for a while, it's possible that there is an airlock in the chimney. Dry up the chimney by burning a piece of paper inside the fire chamber of the fireplace. The draft is sufficient when the chimney draws the ashes upward. After this, you can light the fire.
- Rapid and intense heating can damage the fireplace, especially hasn't been used for a while.
- **Do not close the chimney cover before you are sure that fire and embers have fully extinguished.**
- Remember to close the chimney cover when the fire is out, otherwise the temperature in the apartment may drop due to an open chimney cover.
- **Do not handle the ashes. Ash removal is carried out by staff only. Please contact reception: +358 (0) 10 382 515.**
- Kindly fill up the firewood rack afterwards. It's easier to light the fireplace when the firewood has been indoors for a while. You can find firewood storage right outside your apartment, next to the front door. The storage key is in the hall. Thank you!



IF SMOKE COMES INTO THE APARTMENT:

- Make sure the chimney cover is open
- Make sure the hood above the stove is on at least I-position
- Make sure the fireplace switch is on
- Burn paper in the middle hatch of the fireplace
- Open the apartment window or balcony door
- There is a fire alarm in the apartment. Even a small amount of smoke can release the fire alarm. If you notice that the chimney doesn't work properly, start airing the apartment immediately!
